**Summary:** The "ASCA Mindsets & Behaviors for Student Success: K-12 College- and Career-Readiness Standards for Every Student" describe the knowledge, skills and attitudes students need to achieve academic success, college and career readiness and social/emotional development.

- The 35 mindset and behavior standards identify and prioritize the specific attitudes, knowledge and skills students should be able to demonstrate as a result of a school counseling program. School counselors use the standards to assess student growth and development, guide the development of strategies and activities and create a program that helps students achieve their highest potential.
- **This workshop helps school counselors to:** Operationalize the standards, select competencies that align with classroom lessons, small groups and activities addressing student developmental needs, develop program goals that align with standards, and align with the school's vision and mission.
